



IMPORTANT MEDICAL ALERT

A connection between **Fosamax** and other bisphosphonates with a serious bone disease called Osteonecrosis of Jaw (ONJ) has been found.

Bisphosphonates are commonly used in tablet form to **prevent and treat osteoporosis** in post-menopausal women. They are also used in the **treatment of Paget's disease**. Stronger forms given orally and intravenously (IV) are commonly used in the **management of advanced cancers** including, but not limited to, lung cancer, breast cancer, prostate cancer & multiple myeloma.
